Schedule & Registration

This is a pre-booked event. Registration is between 8.10 and 8.55am on Saturday 24 March in the main foyer of RMIT Kaleide Theatre.

Once registered at the desk you will receive your seminar pass and workbook for the day. You must keep these with you for re-entry to the seminar.

There will be short breaks in the morning and afternoon sessions plus a lunch break scheduled for 1.00pm and 2.00pm.

What Will You Need

You will need your ID, your industry or student concession card if you booked a concession ticket.

You will need to bring your own notebook and pens. We do not provide these on site. You may bring your laptop if it doesn't interfere with the comfort of other participants.

You may not bring recording devices of any kind. They will be confiscated for the duration of the day if found by security staff.

Getting There

Train RMIT Kaleide Theatre is located close to Melbourne Central train station which is serviced by all Metro Melbourne's Train City Loop services. For services that run directly to Flinders Street, visitors to the RMIT Kaleide Theatre can catch a connecting City Loop train service from Flinders Street Station or catch any of the Yarra Tram Swanston Street services (see below).

Tram Most north-south Melbourne city tram services run along Swanston Street (including routes 1, 3, 5, 6, 8, 16, 64, 67 and 72). For those services that run along Elizabeth Street (routes 19, 57, 59) get off at Melbourne Central and walk one block to Swanston Street.

Commuters traveling east-west on services along Flinders Street (routes 48, 70 and 75), Collins Street (routes 109 and 112) or Bourke Street (routes 86 and 96) can catch a connecting Swanston Street service.

Bus Many bus lines offer services connecting to train and tram services listed above. Check Metlink for details of connecting services in your area.
