Epiphany International Artists welcomes you as a valued participant in the Robert McKee Story Seminar. We wish you an inspiring three days taking part in this world acclaimed class on story design.

To Register

Registration is between 8.30am and 9.25am on Friday February 27 in the main foyer at the Kino Cinema, Lower Collins Place, 45 Collins Street, Melbourne.

This seminar is a pre-booked event and we do not use hard copy tickets. Therefore, after booking through Epiphany, you must register your attendance with the staff at the venue to gain entry to the seminar. Only fully paid participants will have their name on the bookings lists.

If you wish to purchase additional tickets at the door, you must pay with cleared funds e.g. exact cash, credit card, money order or bank cheque. It's advisable to ring us the day before to check availability.

What Will You Need

You will need to arrive between 8.30am and 9.15am (at least half an hour before the seminar commences at 9.30am) to register. The registration desk will be operating from 8.30am.

Please bring your ID and industry membership card or student card if you've booked a concession ticket. We also recommend bringing your receipt to avoid potential confusion or delays.

You will be given a conference badge to keep with you throughout the weekend. Re-entry after breaks will require you to display this item.

You will need paper, pens and a clipboard to write on.

You may bring laptops if they do not disturb fellow participants.

We recommend you wear warm, comfortable clothes and bring water, light refreshments or whatever you need to ensure your comfort while sitting for extended periods.

Break times are scheduled every two hours but subject to slight variation to allow the session to reach its conclusion. Morning and afternoon teas are 15 minutes (approx.), lunch is one hour (approx.).

If you're working on a script, you may bring it for your own reference. There are no requirements to share your ideas or information with other participants.

Recording devices are not permitted and will be confiscated for the duration of the seminar. There are no exceptions.

How To Get There

By Car

The Kino Cinema is located between Collins Street and Flinders Street on the eastern side of the city near Springs Street. The parking station is directly underneath Collins Place, which you enter via Flinders Lane.

Option 1: When attending an event at Kino Cinema, the first 2 hours of parking is free, after which it is \$2 per hour (maximum 6 hours). Present your parking ticket at the box office to receive your discount. Please remember you would have to move your car during the day to avoid normal charges.

Option 2: You can also park at Federation Square and pay \$12 for an early bird day rate (enter before 10am and exit by midnight). Weekend rates are only \$8. You then walk up Russell Street, turn right into Collins Street and continue to Collins Place (approx 10 mins).

By Tram

The venue is closest to the Collins Street/Springs Street intersection at the top end of Collins Street, so all trams travelling up and down Collins Street will drop you right outside Collins Place.
