Epiphany International Artists welcomes you as a valued participant in the Robert McKee Story Seminar. We wish you an inspiring three days taking part in this world acclaimed class on story design.

To Register

Registration is between 8.30am and 9.25am on Friday February 20 in the main foyer outside the Ritchie Theatre at The John Niland Scientia Building, University of New South Wales.

This seminar is a pre-booked event and we do not use hard copy tickets. Therefore, after booking through Epiphany, you must register your attendance with the staff at the venue to gain entry to the seminar. Only fully paid participants will have their name on the bookings lists.

If you wish to purchase additional tickets at the door, you must pay with cleared funds e.g. exact cash, credit card, money order or bank cheque. It's advisable to ring us the day before to check availability.

What Will You Need

You will need to arrive between 8.30am and 9.15am (at least half an hour before the seminar commences at 9.30am) to register. The registration desk will be operating from 8.30am.

Please bring your ID and industry membership card or student card if you've booked a concession ticket. We also recommend bringing your receipt to avoid potential confusion or delays.

You will be given a conference badge to keep with you throughout the weekend. Re-entry after breaks will require you to display this item.

You will need paper, pens and a clipboard to write on.

You may bring laptops if they do not disturb fellow participants.

We recommend you wear warm, comfortable clothes and bring water, light refreshments or whatever you need to ensure your comfort while sitting for extended periods.

Break times are scheduled every two hours but subject to slight variation to allow the session to reach its conclusion. Morning and afternoon teas are 15 minutes (approx.), lunch is one hour (approx.).

As the University is not in session in February, we have arranged for 'Tasty Bites', a food outlet on campus, to be open that weekend for participants of the seminar. They sell coffee, sandwiches and rolls, a selection of hot food, snack items and cold drinks. Due to the location and the distance to the surrounding suburbs, we recommend you stay on campus during breaks to avoid being late back into the next session.

If you're working on a script, you may bring it for your own reference. There are no requirements to share your ideas or information with other participants.

Recording devices are not permitted and will be confiscated for the duration of the seminar. There are no exceptions.

How To Get There

By Car

The University of New South Wales is located between Anzac Parade, Kensington and Botany Street, Randwick. Enter via Gate 11 on Botany Street at the rear of the upper campus. There are parking stations directly inside the gates and the Ritchie Theatre is a two minute walk away.

By Bus

From the CBD, take the 394 bus (Sydney Buses) Friday Departs: 8:25am Sydney, Elizabeth Street near St. James Station. Arrives: 8:46am Kensington, Anzac Parade Stand D at UNSW Walk up University Mall (main walkway entrance) from Anzac Parade and follow the path straight up to the John Niland Scientia Building.
